Stay up-to-date on ZDHC MRSL Conformance

CleanChain provides you a variety of ways to stay up-to-date against the **ZDHC MRSL**.


To see where your facility stands against the ZDHC MRSL:

- 1. Navigate to **Dashboard** and select the conformance standard "ZDHC MRSL v1.1" to see how many of your formulations meet the different levels from the ZDHC Gateway.
- 2. On your Dashboard, you can also filter by Product Tag to see how your formulations conform by ZDHC Use Category.

Connect and share

Connections enable you to easily view your supply chain at a glance, share chemical information, and improve communication with your customers and partners.

We heard your feedback, and CleanChain 2.3.1 improves upon connection management. You can easily view all your connections, suppliers, and customers in just a couple of clicks.

To View all Connections:

- 1. Using the left-navigation menu, click "Connections".

Screening enables users to automatically compare product analyses to a chemical standard or substance control list. The screen tool creates data visualizations and tables so you can easily determine the result of the analysis and act.

To use Screening:

- 1. Upload a Product Analysis in the Analysis Section.
- 2. Click Screening.
- 3. Select the product analysis you would like to use. 4. Select the chemical standard or
- substance control list to compare the product analysis against. 5. Click Compare.
